Women Talking Politics: Call for Items

Formerly a newsletter that was suspended after 2009 due to the Christchurch earthquakes, Women Talking Politics is to be brought back at the 2014 NZPSA Conference in December as a new Research Magazine. The first two issues are supported by the NZPSA's Bi-annual Grant. The Lead Editor, Valentina Cardo, is currently calling women to submit either news items of 200-300 words or 800 word research notes, which will be blind peer reviewed. The first issue will aim to reconnect women, their research and events across NZ. Please spread the word to any women who you think has something interesting to say about politics; they do not need to be NZPSA members. We especially want to provide the opportunity for postgraduates to publish. The deadline is 31 October 2014.

Undergraduate Essay Prize

Due to the generosity of Raymond Miller and now Janine Hayward as the new editor of *New Zealand Government and Politics* (OUP, 2015) each year a prize of \$500 is awarded for the <u>best undergraduate essay</u> submitted as part of the requirements for a course on New Zealand domestic politics. One nomination per year can be made by a course convenor at any New Zealand University. So please keep this in mind as you do your final marking for the year, I'm sure one of your students could do with the money.
