### **Gender Workshop Report**

I'm delighted to announce that the report "Advancing the Status of Women in Political Science and International Relations in New Zealand" has been released and is <u>available</u> for viewing on our website.

Stemming from a 2012 workshop to assess the status and progress of women in the academic discipline of political studies, this groundbreaking report brings global research to bear on the status of women in political science, and is the first comprehensive survey of the representation of women in NZ political science.
